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Donald Trump's new mandate – Putin's huge and last opportunity



At a recent annual press conference, the President of Russia, Vladimir Putin, refrained from talking about the presidential elections in the US next year. However, he did not refrain from talking about the outcome he expected.

"When internal changes happen (in the US) (...), then the fundamental conditions will be in place to restore fully-fledged relations. So far, such conditions are not in place, but we are ready for that", said Putin at a 4-hour, firmlycontrolled press conference.

Putin talked about the "internal changes" he expected in the US. However, even though he did not mention him specifically, the name Donald Trump lingered in the air.
